

Reach Truck

Operators should be trained to an essential level of skill to work with Counterbalance trucks safely, efficiently and with competence. By the end of the course the operator should state the reasons for operators training, and pass a basic operative's skills test as set out in the HSE publication Rider-Operated Lift Trucks, Approved Code of Practice, (L117).
